Please be advised by this letter that I am opposed to the request for change to the zoning of the parcel of land denoted on the Key Plan noting the roads named Alps Road., and Spragues Road.

My reasons for being opposed are as follows.

1. The subject properties are too close to where I live. Property values will be affected negatively.
2. Having lived in Erin some years ago, I am well aware of the negatives of being exposed to an active gravel/sand pit. Such as excessive heavy truck traffic and subsequent damage to local roads.
3. Having to replace my sand blasted windscreen after one year of commuting with gravel trucks leaking abrasive particles from their loads.
4. The increase in local traffic of heavy trucks carrying sand and gravel raises road risk, and will probably cause an increase in insurance rates.
